





Webinar on Post-graduation Opportunities in Denmark (28 March, 2025)

The CSI Student Branch hosted a webinar on post-graduation opportunities in Denmark on March 28, 2025, at Mody University of Science and Technology, Lakshmangarh. The session was led by Helle Yding Sørensen from the University of Southern Denmark (SDU). She provided a comprehensive overview of the educational landscape in Denmark, highlighting the university's diverse master's degree programs. She emphasized Denmark's reputation for high-quality education, research excellence, and student-friendly policies, making it an attractive destination for higher studies.



Helle Yding Sørensen elaborated on the various master's degree programs offered by SDU, including engineering, business, social sciences, and health sciences. She detailed the admission procedure, guiding students on the step-by-step process of applying, including selecting the right program based on academic background and career goals, meeting the eligibility criteria such as bachelor's degree requirements and relevant coursework, and preparing essential documents such as transcripts, a statement of purpose, letters of recommendation, and an updated CV. She also explained the language proficiency requirements, typically English proficiency tests like IELTS or TOEFL, and emphasized the importance of submitting applications within the specified deadlines.



To help students enhance their chances of successful admission, the speaker provided insights into effective preparation strategies, including gaining relevant academic and research experience, strengthening communication and analytical skills, actively participating in extracurricular and leadership activities, and researching scholarship opportunities and financial aid options available for international students.



The webinar saw enthusiastic participation from over 100 students. The interactive session at the end allowed students to ask questions regarding tuition fees, scholarship options, post-study work opportunities, and the student experience in Denmark. Helle Yding Sørensen addressed their concerns and encouraged them to consider Denmark as a promising destination for their higher studies.

It equipped them with crucial information on the admission process, preparation strategies, and future prospects.
